William B. "Bill" Carter, 89, of Morganton, NC passed away on Sunday, January 31, 2016. Born in Wilkes-Barre, PA on September 12, 1926, he was the son of the late Carney Blake Carter and Myrtice Greenwood Carter Davis. Mr. Carter was a U.S. Navy veteran of WWII.
