William Mercer Lewis, born July 31, 1930 in Bridgeport, Connecticut, son of Isaac Walker and Wilhelmme Fanton Lewis passed away on August 6, 2014, at Burke Hospice and Palliative Care, with his wife and children by his side.

He served in the United States Navy from July 18, 1950 through July 12, 1956. He worked for the Central Intelligence Agency from 1957 until retiring on August 8, 1980. He went to work for ITT Teves in Culpeper, Virginia for 10 years, retiring for the second time at 62. He was a charter member of the Optimist Club in Culpeper, volunteered with both the St. Stephen's Food Closet and the Friends of the Library.
