



# *Willie Clifton Horton*

**Feb. 28, 1930 - Sept. 10, 2010**

Willie Clifton Horton, Sr., 80, of Brandon Road, Morganton, NC died Friday, September 10, 2010 at the Burke Hospice Palliative Care Center in Valdese, NC following a period of declining health. Born in Cleveland Co., NC on February 28, 1930, he was the son of the late Laton Yates Horton and Blanche Brittain McNeilly. Clifton was a member of Morganton First Church of God where he had served on the Board of Trustees and was an usher and bus driver. He attended Morganton High School and joined the U.S. Navy in 1949. He served for twenty-two years during the Korean and Vietnam Wars. After his service he graduated from Western Piedmont Community College and Gardner-Webb College at the age of 52. Clifton received his bachelor degree in social sciences. He earned his degree while working at the Western Youth Institute and continued his employment there until his retirement in 1997.
